(41) donors arrived to provide the "Gift of Life" as we surpassed our goal of (36). (7) donors were deferred, (25) whole blood pints, and (8 Power reds = 16 pints) were collected, for a total of (41) total units. We had TWO first time donors. Working together, the Port Huron Elks Lodge 343 and the American Red Cross we have collected over 2,867 units (pints) = over 358 gallons of blood since our 1st drive on January 7, 2013. Gold Key Scholarship Program

The Michigan Elks Charitable Grant Fund offers scholarships to help Michigan special-needs students pursue education at accredited colleges, universities, or trade/vocational schools. The goal is to support students who might not otherwise continue their education after high school.

Eligibility Requirements: Applicants must reside in Michigan, have had an IEP or 504 Plan at graduation (or completion of an extended special education program), be a graduating high school senior or a recent graduate (within the past year), enrolled in a public extended education program (RESA/ISD), age 18–25 with documented participation in a treatment program preparing for continued education, and demonstrate financial need. "Special Needs" includes students physically challenged, eligible for special education under federal guidelines, or approved by the Gold Key Commission. Award Details includes \$2,000 per year renewable for up to 3 additional years with proof of enrollment and good standing and paid directly to the educational institution.

Required Documents include an official transcript, Student Application Form, Parent/Guardian letter (200 words or less), letter of recommendation, IEP or 504 Plan, college acceptance letter (required before funds are released), Student Profile Form and Parent/Guardian Financial Form (submitted online). Incomplete applications will not be reviewed.

Applications are reviewed quarterly:

Q1: Jan 1 – Mar 1

Q2: Apr 1 – Jun 1

Q3: Jul 1 – Sep 1

Q4: Oct 1 – Dec 1

Renewals open November 1 each year. Award decisions are issued 30–60 days after each quarter closes.

Students interested in applying can visit www.mielksgoldkey.org, where full eligibility requirements, application instructions, and required documentation are available.

We are officially gearing up for the 2026 golf season, and the Golf Shop is back in motion at the Port Huron Elks! We are excited to release the 2026 Golf Calendar. While additional events may be added during

the season, the core schedule is now set and we are looking forward to a great year of tournaments and events.

New for 2026, we are introducing Couples, Clubs, and Cocktails. These themed Friday evening gatherings will take place once a month during the summer and are built around the experience rather than the scorecard. Each event will feature light appetizers, themed cocktails, and a relaxed social atmosphere designed to bring out family, friends, and guests for a fun summer evening at the club.

All tournament registrations will be completed through the Golf Genius website. The tournament schedule and registration information can be found at: www.phelk-slodge343.com/golf-tournaments.

Beginning in 2026, all tournament entries must be paid in full prior to the event, and all events will follow a 48-hour cancellation policy.

Additionally, all internal tournaments will require an active GHIN handicap. Members who need to establish or renew a GHIN handicap may do so through the Golf Shop. The cost for the 2026 season is \$30.

Once the practice range opens for the season, we ask all members and guests to follow range etiquette guidelines. Due to the size of our range, all practice shots must be 150 yards or less to ensure safety and preserve the condition of the range throughout the season.
