



Seventeen Vietnam veterans were honored Monday, Nov. 3, at Port Huron Elks Lodge 343, where each received a 50-year Vietnam War Commemorative Lapel Pin presented by U.S. Pentagon representative and American Legion 8th District Commander Gene Nethaway.

The ceremony, part of the national United States of America Vietnam War Commemoration, recognized 50 years since the end of the conflict and paid tribute to those who served. Michelle Fickes, Veterans Engagement Officer for the Michigan Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, also presented each veteran with a Michigan Veterans Recognition Pin.

The event was organized by Scott R. Harris, District Deputy Grand Exalted Ruler for Metro District 4200 and Veterans Committee Chair for Lodge 343. Though not a veteran himself, Harris said his commitment to honoring veterans stems from his step-father and father-in-law, both World

War II and Korean War veterans.

"My passion is to serve those who did serve," Harris said. "Through the Elks, I've been able to help ensure veterans receive the recognition they deserve."

Refreshments followed as families, fellow Elks, and community members joined in tribute. Harris emphasized the importance of having a Pentagon representative present, calling it a more meaningful way to honor their service.

"It's our solemn promise that so long as there are veterans, the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks will never forget them," he said.

Harris continues to work with state and national Elks programs to provide resources and host events for veterans across Michigan, including at the McLaren-Port Huron Yale VA Clinic and the Michigan Veterans Home in Chesterfield. Later this week, he, Nethaway, and Fickes will present pins to 96 Vietnam veterans at the Chesterfield facility.

Legacy Awards – \$4,000 Scholarships

The Elks Legacy Awards offer \$4,000 scholarships to children and grandchildren of Elks members.

Deadline: February 2, 2026, at 11:59 a.m. Pacific Time (NOON Pacific Time) Applications open September 1, 2025.

Who Can Apply:

Child, grandchild, stepchild, step-grandchild, or legal ward of a living Elk.

Elk must have joined on or before April 1, 2023 (or be a charter member after that date) and paid dues through March 31, 2026. High school seniors only. Great-grandchildren not eligible. Apply online only—SATACT scores not required. If both parent and grandparent are Elks, list the parent's Lodge.

Students may apply for multiple ENF scholarships but can receive only one. Local and state awards are separate.

Other Details:

Scholarships may be used at accredited U.S. schools, colleges, or universities. (Applicants from Panama, Puerto Rico, and the Philippines may use awards at schools in their home countries.)

Winners must complete three acts of service with an Elks Lodge during college.

How to Apply:

Online applying began September 1, 2025. Visit elks.org/scholars. Questions? Email scholarship@elks.org. Winners announced in late April 2026.
